Agnes moved to Carroll where she was employed at Pauline's Restaurant. While in Carroll she met her future husband Lawrence Sporleder. Agnes and Lawrence were married on July 24, 1947 at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Carroll. The couple made their home near Lidderdale until 1979 when they moved to Carroll. Throughout her working career she continued to work at Pauline's Restaurant and also worked at St. Anthony Hospital as a ward secretary until her retirement in 1981.

Agnes enjoyed quilting, sewing, baking and cooking. She traveled often with her husband and especially enjoyed trips to Oregon and Alaska. She also enjoyed playing cards and the many gatherings with the Weinie Roast Bunch. Her greatest love and joy was her family; she dearly cherished the time spent with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
