Following her schooling Alice helped on her family's farm and also cared for her ailing mother and later worked for Carroll County State Bank.

On July 6, 1957 Alice was united in marriage to Earl Boes at St. John's Catholic Church in Arcadia. The couple made their home in Breda before moving to an acreage east of Breda. Alice raised her children and was also a gifted seamstress; doing alterations and making clothes for many in the Breda community. She enjoyed cooking for her family, quilting, crocheting, and her card clubs that she and Earl participated in for over 30 years. Alice's greatest joy was spending time with her family, especially her granddaughters. She had a deep devotion to her faith, active in the National Catholic Foresters Society, St. Bernard's Parish, Parish Ladies Guild and the Parish Choir.
