Born on August 14, 1933 near Templeton, Iowa, Arthur C. was the son of Leonard and Crecentia (Becker) Willenborg. He grew up near the Templeton community and attended school at Sacred Heart School in Templeton. After his education Art worked at Ocoma Foods, until it's closing, it was there that he met his wife Shirley Armstrong, and they were married on May 25, 1955 at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The couple made their home on a farm near Templeton until they moved to the Dedham community in 1961. Art worked for Crouse Cartage until his retirement, as well as raised cattle.

Art enjoyed restoring antique tractors, and riding in area tractor rides. He is credited with organizing the Dedham Tractor Ride. Most of all Art enjoyed spending time with his family. Art was an Honorary Chapter F.F.A. Degree, an award he was nominated for by his grandson, he also was proud member of the Teamsters, The Old Iron Tractor Club, and St. Joseph's Parish in Dedham.
