Audrey Weitzl, age 96, of Carroll, died Friday, October 13, 2023, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Audrey, the daughter of Joseph and Frances (Balk) Danzer was born on July 12, 1927 at Willey, Iowa. She attended St. Mary's Grade School and later graduated from St. Angela's Academy with the class of 1945. From 1945-1951 she worked as a legal secretary for Meyers and Tan Creti Law Firm.

On June 14, 1951, Audrey was united in marriage to Floyd J. Weitzl. They made their home on a farm northeast of Templeton, where they lived until their retirement to Carroll in 1988. Audrey was a very active volunteer. She volunteered with the following: Holy Spirit Parish, Catholic Daughters, St. Anthony Hospital Auxiliary, Carroll American Legion Auxiliary, New Hope Village Bargain Shop, Carroll Chamber of Commerce, and R.S.V.P.
