Bruce Heim, age 62, of Pocahontas, died Friday, June 7, 2019 at his home in Pocahontas.

In his early years, Bruce enjoyed riding his motorcycle. He also enjoyed traveling, spending time with kids, especially his nieces and nephews. He always enjoyed being around people, and pleasing people.

Left to celebrate Bruce's life is his mother: Esther Heim of Lake City; siblings: Larry Heim, and his wife Vicki of Glidden; Richard Heim, and his wife Melody of Auburn, and Mary Tonsfeldt, and her husband Paul of Grand Junction, as well as his nieces, nephews, and many friends.
