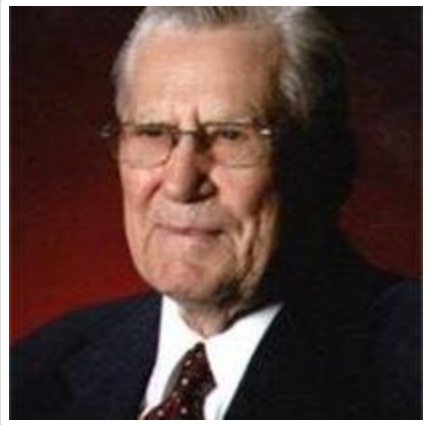




Clarence Ludwig

June 18, 1916 - January 14, 2012

Clarence "Bill" Ludwig, 95 of Breda, died Saturday, January 14, 2012 at the Swan House in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, January 18, 2012 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Richard Remmes. Born on June 18, 1916 at Breda, Iowa, Clarence was the son of Albert and Elizabeth (Nepple) Ludwig. Bill spent his entire lifetime in the Breda area and attended St. Bernard's School. On May 10, 1944 he married Lillian Wernimont at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church. Lillian passed away in January of 1952 and on June 25, 1976 Bill married Verna Gerken. He was a lifelong farmer and dairyman. In 1929 Bill bought his first registered Heifer. He received many local and statewide honors for his registered Holstein cow herd. Bill was active

in the Holstein Association where he attended many national shows and meetings. Bill was a talented woodworker and also enjoyed the company of his family. He was a member of the State and National Holstein Associations, West Central Dairy Herd Improvement Association, Breda Catholic Order of Foresters, and St. Bernard's Parish in Breda.

Survivors include his son, Mark Ludwig and his wife Connie of Breda; his grandchildren: Nicholas (Jaime) Ludwig and their children, Evan and Ethan of Stilwell, KS, Josh Ludwig of Breda, and David Ludwig of Breda; his stepchildren: Don (JoAnn) Gerken of Breda, Marlene Goecke of Remsen, LeRoy (Judy) Gerken of Columbia, MO, Rosemary (Larry) Daniel of Lidderdale, and Karen (Tom) Freis of Omaha, NE; 18 step-grandchildren; 46 step-great-grandchildren; his sister: Helen Heithoff of Coon Rapids; his sisters-in-law: Thelma Wernimont of Carroll, Marie Wernimont of Sioux City, Agnes Meiners of Jefferson, and Jeanette Liechti of Arcadia; his brother-in-law, Wayne (Betty) Anderson of Carroll; as well as other relatives and many friends.
