Clarice Loehr, 87 of Carroll, died early Sunday morning, September 20, 2015 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Clarice was employed at St. Lawrence with the hot lunch program for 9 years and in 1970 joined her husband in the family business, Loehr's Jewelry, which is owned and operated currently by their son Michael Loehr.

Clarice enjoyed golfing, sewing, crocheting, cooking and lake life at Lake View and Lake Panorama. Mrs. Loehr was a member of St. Lawrence Church and Parish Ladies Guild.
