Dan Stoolman, 68 of Carroll, died Sunday, March 24, 2024 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Born on November 20, 1955, Daniel Stoolman was the son of Donald and Agnes (Neppel) Stoolman. He attended Holy Family School in Lidderdale, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School and later graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School. Dan was united in marriage to Sheryl Venner on August 14, 1976 at St. Francis Church in Maple River. The couple resided in several communities before settling in Carroll in 1984. To this union were three children, Rachel, Chuck, and Andy.

For most of his working career, Dan was employed with Feld Fire Equipment in Carroll. He enjoyed spending time with his family and watching his children's activities. Dan was an avid collector of many things; loved telling a good story and thoroughly enjoyed his time at Lake View.
