Delbert Brincks, age 81, of Carroll, Iowa, died early Thursday, November 5, 2009, at his residence in Carroll. He volunteered extensively at St. Lawrence Parish and Kuemper High School and was a sixteen gallon donor to the Red Cross Bloodmobile.
