Delores Kasperbauer, 90 of Carroll, died peacefully on Monday, January 3, 2022, at Swan Place in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m., Friday, January 7, 2022, at St. John Paul II Parish – Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Kevin Richter.
