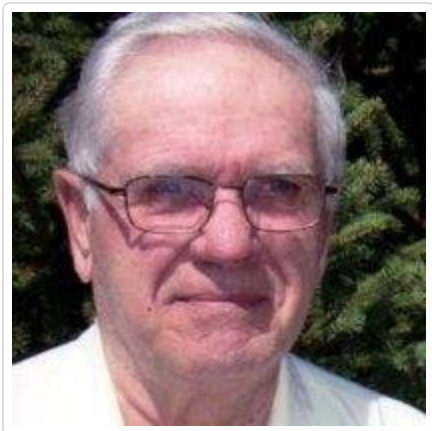




Don E. Pottebaum

Don Pottebaum, 81 of Carroll and formerly of Lidderdale, died early Thursday morning, December 19, 2013 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Born on May 12, 1932 at Carroll, Iowa, Donald Edward was the son of John and Coletta (Timmerman) Pottebaum. Don attended Sts. Peter and Paul

School and then worked as a hired man for area farmers until being drafted in the United States Army, serving during the Korean Conflict. Following his honorable discharge he returned to the Carroll area and was married to Elaine Rotert on August 12, 1959 at Holy Family Catholic Church in Lidderdale. For most of his working career Don helped several area farmers with their farm operations and the last ten years prior to retirement he worked in the Maintenance Department at New Hope Village in Carroll. Don and Elaine spent nearly 30 years living in the Lidderdale Community; while living there Don was a member of the Lidderdale Fire Department, Holy Family Parish, and also served on the City Council. He enjoyed fishing, playing cards, spending time with his family and took great pride in his grandchildren and great grandchildren.
