Doreen Polking, 90, of Breda, died Wednesday, February 26, 2014, at SunnyBrook Assisted Living in Carroll.

Born on August 24, 1923, Doreen Louise was the daughter of William and Mary (Heisterkamp) Poen. She attended St. Bernard School in Breda. On November 24, 1942, Doreen was united in marriage to Raymond Polking at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. She was a devoted homemaker, wife, mother, and grandmother. In her later years Doreen worked at Twilight Acres Nursing Home where she was a member of the dietary staff. Doreen lived and raised her family by a quote from Mother Teresa, "A joyful heart is the normal result of a heartwarming love." Doreen represented this in her love to her children and grandchildren. She never gave up and always forgave, and gave second, third, and fourth chances. She always dealt many a pass. Doreen enjoyed playing cards-belonging to thirteen card clubs, sports, especially Hawkeye, Cyclone, and Creighton athletics. She was a member of the National Order of Women Foresters, St. Bernard's Ladies Guild, and St. Bernard's Parish.
