Ed Danzer, 79 of Carroll, died Sunday, April 22, 2012 at his residence in Carroll following a courageous battle with multiple myeloma cancer.

Born on November 4, 1932 at Willey, Iowa, Edmund J. was the son of Joseph and Frances (Balk) Danzer. He attended St. Mary's grade school and later graduated from Carroll High School with the Class of 1950. Ed volunteered his service to the United States Army from 1954 to 1956. He married Joan Schettler on May 17, 1956 at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church in Mt. Carmel. Ed and Joan made their home northeast of Willey where he was a lifelong farmer and raised Charolais cattle. Throughout his lifetime he was active in many organizations: Willey Rockets 4-H, West Central Iowa Chapter of Compassionate Friends, Carroll County Cattle Book Committee, Carroll County Cattleman's Association, Iowa Cattleman's Association, and the American International and Iowa Charolais Associations. Ed loved spending time with his family and friends, socializing, playing cards and fishing. He enjoyed traveling, meeting new people and new places with his loving wife Joan. Ed had a knack for meeting new people and always liked to visit with family, friends and fellow cattlemen. He was very proud of all of his grandchildren and was a great supporter of all of their activities. Ed was a lifelong member of St. Mary's Parish, Carroll Knights of Columbus, and the Dedham American Legion.
