Elsie Hausman, 97, of Carroll, passed away peacefully on Sunday, March 16, 2025, at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll, surrounded by her loved ones.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, March 22, 2025, at St. John Paul II Parish – St. Lawrence Church in Carroll, with Fr. Patrick Behm serving as the Celebrant.
