Born on June 1, 1934 at Maple River, Iowa, Emaline was the daughter of Frank (X.F.) and Matilda (Kennebeck) Hoffman. She spent her younger years in the Maple River area and attended St. Francis School. On February 24, 1954 she was united in marriage to Cletus Halbur at St. Francis Catholic Church in Maple River with Fr. Peter M. Mattes officiating. The couple farmed one year south of Halbur and then moved to their farm northwest of Coon Rapids where they farmed until 1980 when they moved to Carroll. After moving to Carroll, Emaline worked at New Hope Village. She enjoyed creating silk flower bouquets for weddings, anniversaries, but her greatest joy was her family; especially her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Following the passing of her husband Cletus in 2006, Emaline was a resident at the Carroll Health Center and then became a resident at Thomas Rest Haven in Coon Rapids where she passed away on Monday at the age of 79. 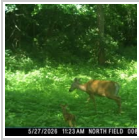
Emaline was preceded in death by her parents; her husband Cletus in 2006; one sister, Melvina Wuebker; and one brother, Eugene Hoffman.
