Eugene Pawletzki, 76, of Carroll, died Friday, September 25, 2015, at his home surrounded by his family.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 30, 2015, at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Craig Collison. Born on October 5, 1938, at Carroll, Iowa, Eugene A. was the son of Henry and Grace (Huegerich) Pawletzki. He grew up on a farm near Maple River, Iowa. Eugene attended St. Francis School, and graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School in Carroll in 1957. After high school Eugene enlisted in the United States Navy where he proudly served his country from 1957 to 1962.

On August 19, 1967 Eugene was united in marriage to Karen Ryan at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Pocahontas, Iowa. He worked in appliance delivery and repair at Witt Hardware in Carroll. In 1977 he started working for General Electric in Carroll, where he worked in maintenance for 19 years. After G.E. Eugene worked for 1 year at Seidl Electric before retiring. After his retirement Eugene was self-employed free-lancing several jobs.

Eugene enjoyed being a handyman of all trades, spending time and activities with his wife, children, and grandchildren. Eugene was a member of the Carroll American Legion, and St. Lawrence Parish in Carroll.

Eugene is survived by his wife of 48 years, Karen Pawletzki of Carroll.
