Florence Odendahl, age 96 of Carroll, died Sunday evening, January 16, 2011 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Born on January 11, 1915 at Templeton, Iowa, Florence was the daughter of John G. and Catherine (Mock) Schoeppner. She spent her younger years in Templeton and attended Sacred Heart School later receiving her nurses

training in Carroll. On August 25, 1937 she was married George Odendahl at Santa Fe, New Mexico with Florence's brother Rev. Msgr. Clarence Schoeppner officiating. The Odendahls farmed north of Carroll until 1983 when they moved to Carroll. Florence always enjoyed sewing, gardening and was an avid reader. Mrs. Odendahl was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, St. Lawrence Ladies Guild, St. Anthony Hospital Auxiliary, Rug Making Auxiliary, and also volunteered many years for New Hope Village.
