Fred Kaus, age 92, of Carroll, Iowa, died Thursday, June 4, 2009, at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll. Funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 A.M., Saturday, June 13, 2009, at St. Lawrence Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Father Timothy Schott. Lector will be Marylynn Kaus. Survivors include his children, Karen Archer and her husband Victor of Oxnard, Calif., James Kaus and his wife Marylynn of Raleigh, North Carolina, and Thomas Kaus and his wife Mary Beth of Lake

Zurich, Illinois; eight grandchildren, Michael Slater and his wife Nina, Andrea Slater, Kathleen Whitley and her husband Robert, Jason Kaus and his wife Susan, Adam Kaus and his wife Crystal, Dave Kaus and his fiancé Jackie Cooney, Steve Kaus and his wife Vi, and Vincent Archer; ten great grandchildren; and a sister-in-law, Betty Eischeid of Carroll.
