George Dozler, 69 of Carroll, died Thursday, July 19, 2012 at the Taylor Hospice House in Des Moines, Iowa.

Following his formal education George was employed by the Carroll County Maintenance Department and also served in the Army National Guard. After his 43 years of service with the county, George retired. He also served on the Carroll Fire Department from 1977 – 2002. George was a member of St. Lawrence Parish in Carroll and was active as an usher. He enjoyed golfing, woodworking, working outdoors, and fishing with his grandchildren.
