Jeff Grote, age 47, of Ankeny, formerly of Breda, died Friday, August 3, 2018 at his home in Ankeny.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, August 8, 2018 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Mark Stoll. Music will be by Marilyn Hundling, and the St. Bernard's Choir. Lector will be Alvin Mueggenberg. Jeffrey Michael, was born on October 26, 1970 in Carroll, Iowa, the son of Elmer and Lois (Neppi) Grote. He grew up on the family farm southwest of Breda, and attended grade school at St. Bernard's School, before graduating from Kuemper Catholic High School in Carroll. After high school he enlisted in the Army National Guard, but health issues required Jeff to resign from his enlistment.

Jeff held various positions in the area. While working he was constantly striving to make current items better, and innovate new designs. Jeff held multiple patents on anti-theft products for semi-tractors and other transportation. He enjoyed tinkering with anything mechanical, and he appreciated visiting with people and carrying on a long conversation, even if they were complete strangers.
