March 1, 1951 - January 31, 2014

Joe Badding, 62 of Carroll, died unexpectedly on Friday morning at his residence in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Music will be by Barb McDermott and the Holy Spirit Choir. Mass Servers will be Parker and Mallory Badding. Lectors for the funeral mass will be: Janet Badding and Bill Badding. Born on March 1, 1951 at Carroll, Iowa, John Joseph Badding was the son of William and Rose (Schroeder) Badding. He spent his younger years in the Arcadia area and attended St. John's School and later graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School with the Class of 1969. Joe served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, receiving the National Defense Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, and Vietnam Campaign Medal.

On May 19, 1973 he was united in marriage to Doreen "Surge" Golwitzer at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll. Joe and Surge made their home in Carroll where he worked at Badding Construction and later owned and operated L& J Construction. In 1986 Joe began working for Pella Corporation where he was currently employed.

Joe enjoyed golfing, camping, Iowa State Cyclones, listening to Rush Limbaugh on talk radio, and having a refreshment with his family and friends. Joe's greatest joy was his family, especially his children and his grandchildren. He was a member of the Arcadia American Legion.
