Kathleen (Kaye) Riddle was born December 31, 1924 in Denison, Iowa, the daughter of James and Nora (Fitzpatrick) Keating. One of seven children, Kaye, graduated from Denison High School in 1942.

After high school Kaye worked fulltime and enjoyed going to dances. At one of these dances she met Louis Riddle. They were married in Denison in June of 1948. They started their family in Denison, but moved from Denison to Carroll in 1955. Kaye and Louis were blessed with five children. Kaye had several jobs in Carroll, she was the neighborhood 'Welcome Wagon Lady', and she had jobs at Wilkie Drug, Moore Brothers, Carroll Bowl and Garden of Gifts. Kaye was a member of St. Lawrence Parish in Carroll. She was an avid bowler and she loved playing cards with friends and family. Kaye also enjoyed crocheting and going to the casino.

Kaye moved from her home in Carroll to the Swan Place in October of 2014. She moved to the Hawkeye Care Center in February of 2015.
