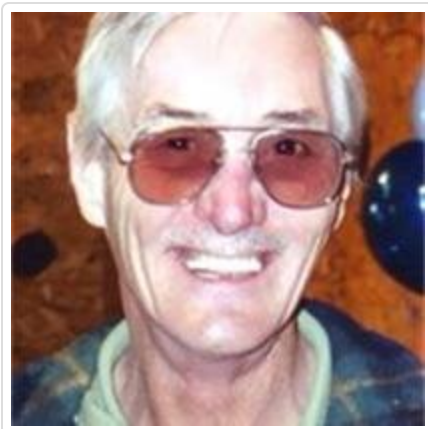




Kenneth Kokenge
