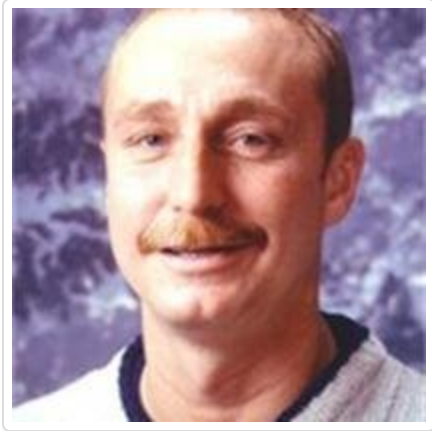




Kenneth Stork

Kenny Stork, age 49, of Breda, Iowa, died Saturday, December 20, 2008, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll of complications Lou Gehrig's Disease. Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 A.M., Wednesday, December 24, 2008, at St. Bernard Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Father Joe Dillinger. Lector will be Brenda Ridings. Mr. Stork was born on June 12, 1959, at Carroll, Iowa, the son of Matt H. and Mary Ann (Grabner) Stork. He grew up in the Breda community and attended St. Bernard School and after the family moved to Carroll he attended St. Lawrence School and graduated from Kuemper High School in 1977. He entered the U.S. Air Force in December 1977 and was honorably discharged in January 1983 at the rank of Sergeant. Following military service he was employed by the Pella

Corporation in Carroll. On December 29, 1984, he was married to Michelle Warnke at St. Lawrence Church in Carroll. The family moved to Breda in 1988 when Mr. Stork and his brother, Henry Stork purchased Zeke's Place in Breda. They operated the Breda restaurant until 2002 when Mr. Stork became manager of the Carroll Municipal Golf Course, a position he holds to this day. He was a member of St. Bernard Parish and Breda American Legion. Mr. Stork was a people person and enjoyed playing golf and watching his kids play golf, gambling, fishing, watching golf on television, working, and family activities.
