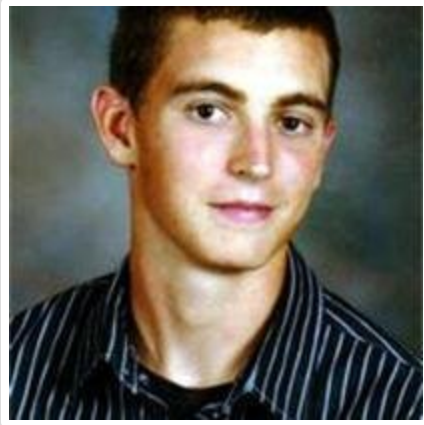




Kyle Pudenz

January 2, 1993 - March 25, 2012

Kyle Pudenz, 19 of Carroll, died Sunday, March 25, 2012 at Covenant Medical Center in Waterloo, Iowa from injuries received in an accident.

Born on January 2, 1993 at Carroll, Iowa, Kyle Nicholas Pudenz was the son of Brad and Michele (Halbur) Pudenz. He grew up in the Carroll area and attended Christ the King Grade School in Mt. Carmel. Kyle later attended Kuemper Catholic Schools and graduated with the Class of 2011. While at Kuemper he was active in track and baseball, participating in State Track Meets and two State Baseball Tournament Teams. Kyle was also a member of the Carroll Merchant's Baseball Team that finished first in the 2011 State Tournament and runner-up at the National Tournament. He enjoyed playing all intramural sports and fishing. He loved hanging out and spending time with his family and many friends. Kyle was attending Hawkeye Community College in Waterloo and was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Lidderdale. Kyle will be sadly missed and will always be remembered for his kind hearted, easy going, unselfish character, always thinking of others before himself.
