Lawrence Dentlinger, 92 of Arcadia, died Sunday, August 9, 2015, at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Born on January 29, 1923, on the family farm near Arcadia, Iowa, Lawrence Francis was the son of Joseph and Anna (Hoelscher) Dentlinger. There he grew up, and attended St. John's Grade School. After his education Lawrence worked for the Collison Brothers and Bert Vonnahme. Lawrence then started his own farming operation where he farmed near Manning, and thereafter near Westside, and then near Arcadia. On February 12, 1947, Lawrence was united in marriage to Arlene Friedman at Holy Angels Catholic Church in Roselle. To this union 11 children were born. In 1993 Lawrence retired, and he and Arlene moved into Arcadia.

Lawrence enjoyed fishing, playing cards and games, county fairs, polka music, and attending a multitude of events to support his children and grandchildren. Lawrence was a member of a card club, the Carroll 4th Degree Knights of Columbus, and he was also a lifelong member of St. John's Parish, where he served as a long-time parish trustee, lector, Eucharistic minister and altar server.
