He spent his entire lifetime in the Roselle Community and attended Holy Angels Grade School, later graduating from Kuemper Catholic High School with the Class of 1980. On September 30, 1995 he was united in marriage to Wendy Venteicher at Holy Angels Catholic Church in Roselle. Leo furthered his education with an Associate in Claims from the Insurance Institute of America and a Bachelor's in Science from the University of Phoenix University.
