Leo Staiert, 89 of Carroll, died Saturday, September 20, 2014 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Born on December 30, 1924 at Carroll, Iowa, Leo Cletus was the son of John and Anna (Niehaus) Staiert. He grew up in rural Carroll and received his early education at St. Francis Catholic School in Maple River. Lefty, as he was known to his family and friends, worked on the family farm and later worked for his sister and brother-in-law, Hilda and Joe Bruch on their family farm near Fonda.

On September 12, 1951 Leo was united in marriage to Alice Renze at Holy Angels Catholic Church in Roselle. The couple farmed for 49 years in the Lytton and Roselle areas. Leo was active in Holy Angels Parish where he served in various capacities. For years, he was the voice of "Bingo" at the annual Roselle Parish Celebration.

In 2000, following his retirement, Leo and Alice moved to Carroll where they were members of St. Lawrence Parish and blessed with wonderful neighbors.

Leo had a passion for baseball and enjoyed a good game of cards with family and friends. He also enjoyed car rides to view the countryside scenery and wildlife. Leo cherished family and thoroughly enjoyed sharing in the lives and activities of his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.
