Leon B. "Lee" Hermesen, age 86, of Mt. Carmel, died, Wednesday, September 10, 2008 at St. Anthony's Regional Hospital in Carroll. He graduated from St. Bernard's High School in Breda. Following his schooling Lee began farming near Mt. Carmel. For his entire life Lee was a grain and livestock farmer in the Mt. Carmel area until his retirement. Lee enjoyed baseball, golfing, fishing, hunting, trapping, bowling and playing the organ. Lee often was a host to the patrons of Mt. Carmel for coffee and socializing in the old Fleskes store. Lee was a member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church in Mt. Carmel. Survivors include, one brother, Edmund (Mary) Hermesen of Cudahy, Wisconsin; one sister, Joan (Wilbur) Baumhover of Fonda; 11 nieces and nephews, and other relatives and friends. Paul Hermesen; two sisters, Helen Mulligan and Catherine Hermesen.
