Leona Klocke, age 86, of Carroll, died Wednesday, February 18, 2015, at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday, February 21, 2015 at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Schott. Music will be by Kate Cuddy and the St. Lawrence Choir. Lector will be Leona's son-in-law Ray Reineke. Born on June 3, 1928 in Dedham, Iowa, Leona was the daughter of Frank and Catherine (Starman) Bierl. She grew up near the Dedham community, and attended school at St. Joseph's School in Dedham. On April 26, 1949 Leona was united in marriage to Leonard Klocke at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Dedham with Fr. Henry Pick officiating. The couple made their home south of Willey where Leona was a devoted homemaker, and active in the grain and livestock farming operation. The couple retired to the Carroll community in 1992.

Leona enjoyed volunteering. She volunteered at St. Mary's School in Willey and St. Joseph's School in Dedham; she was active with the St. Anthony Hospital Auxiliary, St. Mary's and St. Lawrence Church Guilds, as well as spending many hours volunteering with the R.S.V.P. and New Hope Village in Carroll. Leona also enjoyed gardening, canning, quilting, and embroidery, but most of all Leona enjoyed the time she spent with her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Leona was a former member of St. Mary's Parish and Guild of Willey, and a current member of St. Lawrence Parish and Guild in Carroll.
