Leona Seidl, 83 formerly of Dedham, died Saturday, March 31, 2012 at the Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, Nebraska.

Born on April 12, 1928 at Willey, Iowa, Leona Margaret was the daughter of Henry and Laura (Grote) Oswald. She attended St. Mary's School in Willey through the 8th grade. After her schooling Leona worked for many families in the area caring for their children when new babies were born. She talked fondly of Marie Schumacher's family and cared for many of their children. On September 27, 1949 she married John J. Seidl at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Willey. John and Leona made their home southeast of Dedham at the family farm where she was a dedicated wife and mother to their nine children. Leona loved her family and always enjoyed cooking for their many family gatherings. She loved spending time with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren who lovingly called her GG. Leona enjoyed sending cards to her family and many friends for various occasions and also enjoyed making crafts.
