Peter and Paul Church in Carroll by Fr. Lambert Schenkelberg. Following their marriage they made their home in Carroll and raised their six children. Leone was a member of Holy Spirit Parish and Parish Ladies Guild. Leone enjoyed people whether it was going downtown for coffee or hosting dinner parties at her home. She enjoyed music, flowers, and spending time with her family.
