LeRoy Balk, 78 of Templeton, died early Saturday morning, September 5, 2015 at the Manning Regional Healthcare Center.

Born on September 19, 1936 at Willey, Iowa, LeRoy was the son of Clem and Florence (Wiskus) Balk. At a young age, LeRoy moved with his family to Templeton where he attended a country school and later graduated from Sacred Heart School with the Class of 1955.

On August 23, 1958, LeRoy was united in marriage to Judy Schaeuble at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Templeton with Fr. Leo Harpenau officiating. To this union were seven children.
