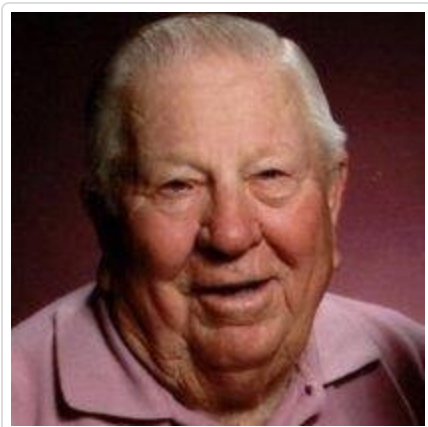




Leroy Vonnahme

Leroy Vonnahme, 86 of Arcadia, died Saturday, August 24, 2013 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Leroy Henry Vonnahme was born on May 14, 1927 in Arcadia, the son of John and Leona (Otto) Vonnahme. He grew up on the family farm west of Arcadia. He attended St. John's Catholic School and Arcadia High School. Following his school years Leroy enlisted in the United States Air Force, serving from 1946 to 1949. Upon returning to the area he worked for H.F. Schroeder Construction, and then he started his own dozer company, Leroy's Dozer Service. On October 9, 1951 he was united in marriage to Norma Jean Wolterman at St. John's Catholic Church in Arcadia, by Father Stork. Leroy was a member of the Arcadia American Legion, Woodman of the World, Knights of Columbus, and St. John's Parish. Over the years he enjoyed fishing, bowling, golf, playing cards, and slow pitch softball, but most of all he enjoyed spending time with family and friends, especially his grandchildren and great grandchildren.
