Her husband died in February 1981 and Mrs. Steinkamp moved to her home in Breda in 1984. She was a member of

St. Bernard Parish and Parish Ladies Guild. Mrs. Steinkamp enjoyed her family, gambling, going to the Dog Racing Track, cooking, and driving around in her car.
