News Newspaper for many years. She was a member of St. Bernard Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, and the Breda American Legion Auxiliary. Survivors include her sons, Jack Quinlin and his wife Carole of North Bend, Wash., and Tom Quinlin and his wife Joan of Ankeny; a daughter-in-law, Hilda Quinlin of Omaha, Nebr.; sixteen grandchildren; and forty-five great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, Lester "Mike" Quinlin, in 1973; a son, Richard Quinlin, in 2008; her parents; a brother, Norman Smid; and sisters, Hazel Koenig and Lorna Tiefenthaler.
