Marie Wendl, daughter of Charles and Mary (Stoberl) Muhlbauer, was born May 21, 1927, at home northeast of Manning, Iowa. She attended school in Halbur, IA.

On January 7, 1947, Marie was united in marriage with Vic Wendl at St. Augustine's Church in Halbur, IA. Nine children were born to this union. The couple farmed south of Willey, IA. After their retirement from farming in 1981, they moved to Carroll, IA. Marie and Vic enjoyed playing cards, singing with the RSVP choral group, volunteering, and visiting family. They also traveled over the years through most of the United States and several countries in Europe, including a visit to family in Germany.

Marie was a talented seamstress and enjoyed cooking, volunteering at New Hope Village, and gardening. When Vic had a severe stroke in 2007, Marie moved to Sunnybrook Assisted Living for 3.5 years (Sept 2009-March 2013). In March of 2013, Marie suffered a severe stroke and moved to Omaha for rehabilitation and ultimately long term care at Hillcrest County Estates. She lived there 3 ½ years until her death on September 16, 2016 at the age of 89.

Preceding Marie in death are her parents; husband, Vic in 2010, six brothers: Chas (Ann), Joe, Hank (Ruby), Tony (Laura), Bill and Louis Muhlbauer; sisters Sophie (Wayne) Kuhse and Rosie Nulle. Brother-in-laws Alphonse, Leo (Frances) and Paul (Irene); and sister-in-law's: Nell (Henry) Meiners and Sister Joan Marie Wendl; daughter-in-law, Kirstin Wendl.
