Marvin Danner, age 53, of Carroll, Iowa, died Monday, April 19, 2010, of injuries received in a motorcycle/auto accident at the east edge of Carroll on Highway 30.

On February 17, 1979, he was married to Dianne Reiling at St. Lawrence Church in Carroll. The couple farmed northeast of Willey and in 2004 moved to their home in Carroll. After they

moved to Carroll Marvin continued to farm and since 1997 was also employed in the wood shop at the Pella Corporation. He was a former member of St. Mary Parish at Willey and currently was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, the Harley Owners Group, Carroll County Farm Bureau, and was an FFA sponsor. Marvin dearly loved his family, especially his grandson Joshua, and enjoyed farming, riding his Harley, woodworking, and target shooting.
