Mary Lou Hartl, age 81, of Carroll, died Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Mary Lou, the daughter of Clarence and Dorothy (Dufner) Reinart was born on

June 22, 1940 in Halbur, Iowa. At a young age the family moved to Carroll where she attended Sts. Peter and Paul School and graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School in 1958.

On June 1, 1963 Mary Lou was united in marriage to Joseph Hartl at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Carroll. The couple made their home in Audubon County for a few years before moving to Willey in 1967. The couple remained in Willey until Joseph's passing when she moved to Carroll in 1986.

Over the years Mary Lou worked at Pauline's Café, as a dispatcher at National Bi-Products, Tony's Restaurant, M.C.'s Country Café until her retirement. After retirement Mary Lou kept busy by traveling, collecting clowns, weekly coffee sessions with family and friends, and most of all she enjoyed being around her family. She was a former parishioner of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Willey, and current parishioner of St. Lawrence in Carroll.
