Melvina Hahn, age 85, of Carroll died Tuesday, March 17, 2015, at Regency Park Nursing Home in Carroll.

After their marriage the couple made their home near the Roselle community where Melvina was a devoted homemaker. In 1983 the couple moved to the Carroll community. Melvina enjoyed sewing, flowers, polka music, and spending time with her family and friends. She was a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll, where she was also active with the Women's Guild.
