Born on July 19, 1923 at the family farm near Willey, Iowa, Paul Bernard was the son of Ben W. and Catherine (Berger) Brincks. He grew up near Willey, and graduated from St. Mary's School. On June 7, 1948 Paul was united in marriage to Irene Behrens at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Carroll, with Fr. Lambert Schenkelberg officiating. Paul started farming the family farm southeast of Carroll in 1949. Paul and Irene moved to the Carroll community in November of 1994.

Paul enjoyed farming, working on small engines, and woodworking. Most of all Paul enjoyed the time he spent with his family, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Paul was a member of the Carroll Knights of Columbus, Holy Spirit Men's Club, and Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.
