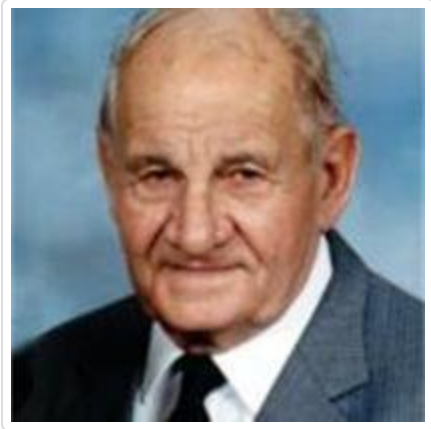




Paul Mayer

Born on June 29, 1923 at Templeton, Iowa, Paul Mayer was the son of Frank

and Teresa (Bluml) Mayer. He spent his younger years in the Templeton area and attended country schools. Paul was married to Theresa Starman on May 14, 1946 at St. John's Church in Adair, Iowa. Following their marriage the couple farmed near Manning before moving to Carroll in 1956. Paul worked at Juergens Produce and Feed for many years as a feed grinder and also assisted with the lawn care business. In retirement Paul enjoyed attending daily Mass, doing lawn work, and watching the traffic drive by from his seat on the front porch. Throughout his lifetime Paul was in various Polka Bands and played numerous instruments including: the banjo, accordion, drums, tuba and the harmonica. Paul was a member of the Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.
