Paul Thomas Siemann, 71, passed away surrounded by his loving family, from complications of the flu, in Denver, Colorado on December 25th, 2022.

A Funeral Mass will be held at 10 a.m., Saturday, May 20, 2023, at Holy Spirit Church – St. John Paul II Parish in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Allan Reicks. Music will be by Kathy Halbur.
