Paul was born on May 19, 1928 in Carroll, Iowa, the son of Lawrence and Mary (Kanne) Wieland. He graduated from Carroll High School in 1946 and served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. In 1952, following his honorable discharge he returned to Carroll and was united in marriage to Lorraine "Rainy" Masching on January 11, 1954 at Sts. Peter & Paul Church in Carroll. Paul and Rainy made their home in Carroll where they raised their children. Paul was employed at Juergen's Produce & Feed for over 50 years until his retirement.
