They lived in Fonda many years where she worked in many retail businesses, catered, and worked part time for 10 years for the Iowa Liquor Commission.

Phyllis and Raymond moved to their farm north of Breda in 1982. Raymond passed away on November 28, 1988. She moved into Breda in 2000, and into SunnyBrook Assisted Living on April 24, 2009.
