Ralph J. "Whitey" Beyerink, age 78, of Roselle, died Tuesday August 16, 2016 at his home surrounded by his family.

Born on July 18, 1938 at Old Carrollton, Iowa, Ralph was the son of Albert and Mary Magdalena "Lena" (Broich) Beyerink. He grew up near Coon Rapids, and attended Annunciation Catholic School. After his formal education Ralph helped his father with the family's farming operation.

On August 29, 1958 Ralph was united in marriage to Lois Bauer at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Willey. Their union was blessed with six children. The couple made their home in Coon Rapids for a brief time before moving to Roselle, where they have made their home for over 50 years. Over the years Ralph worked as a tree surgeon for Gute Tree Service, and Snyder Tree Service, and for 29 years he worked at Farmland Foods in Carroll.

Ralph enjoyed cooking for his family, making sure his meals were meticulously prepared for everyone. He also enjoyed the St. Louis Cardinals, fishing, hunting, and playing cards. The biggest delight of Ralph's life was the time he spent with his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Ralph will be remembered for a deep devotion to his faith. He was a member of Holy Angels Parish in Roselle.
