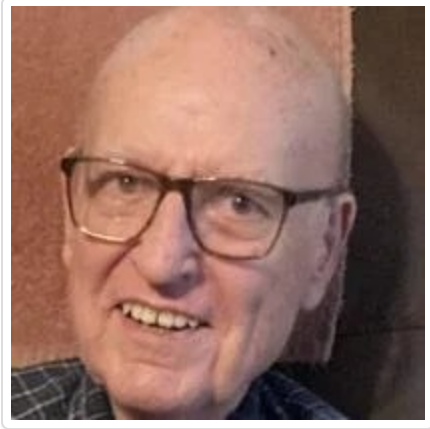




Raymond Daniel

Raymond Daniel, 82 of Carroll, passed away on Wednesday, August 5, 2026, at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Fire Department for 13 years, and in 1986 and 1987, Ray received the award for answering the most calls. Ray loved his family with all his heart.
