Born on February 12, 1927 near Willey, Iowa, Robert Grossman was the son

of Bernard and Mary (Berger) Grossman. He spent his entire lifetime in the Willey area and attended St. Mary's School. On January 30, 1951 he married Lorena Tunning at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Dedham. The couple made their home northeast of Willey where Bob was a grain and livestock farmer, retiring in 1988. Bob and Lorena continued to make their home near the family farm and in February of 2012 as his health began to fail he became a resident at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll. Bob was an avid sports fan, playing ball in his younger years, later being a volunteer umpire for various teams in the area. He was a huge St. Louis Cardinals fan but enjoyed watching all sports on television. Bob enjoyed socializing and making daily visits to the Willey Tavern. He was a lifelong member of St. Mary's Parish in Willey and had also served on the Kuemper Parent's Club.
