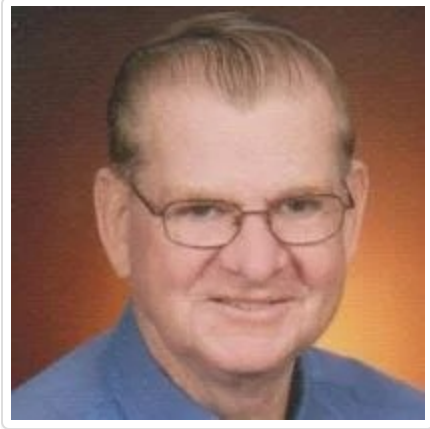




## Robert Wiskus

December 9, 1942 - February 4, 2025

Robert Louis (Bob) Wiskus, 82, of Manning, passed away February 4, 2025 at Thomas Rest Haven in Coon Rapids.

A Funeral Mass will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, February 18, 2025 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Manning. The Celebrant will be Fr. Michael Cronin. Concelebrant will be Fr. Andrew Hoffmann. Bob served in the Army for a short time in 1964 before being honorably discharged.

On October 28, 1967, Bob was united in marriage with Gay Lynne Balukoff at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Dedham, Iowa. From this union were born three children Tina, Terri, and Steve. The couple lived in Dedham, Templeton and Manning.

Bob held various jobs over the years. He enjoyed farming and raising cattle. Bob is best remembered, as "The Pizza Man" from his time working at Casey's in Manning. Bob enjoyed coffee with friends and spending time with his kids and grandchildren. Bob always had a warm smile and a kind word. He never met a stranger.

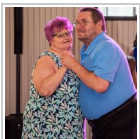
