



Roger "Rocker" Snyder

October 22, 1935 - August 13, 2014

Roger "Rocker" Snyder, 78, of Breda, died Wednesday, August 13, 2014, at his home surrounded by his family.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be at 10 a.m. Saturday, August 16, 2014 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Gary Snyder. Mass servers will be Tucker Boeckman and Matt Wessling. Music will be by Marilyn Hundling and the St. Bernard's Choir. Lectors will be Rocker's son, Doug Snyder, and grandson Reace Snyder. Gift bearers will be Rocker's grandchildren Lane Snyder, Riley Snyder, and great-granddaughter Claire Snyder. Eucharistic minister will be Rocker's daughter-in-law, Lori Snyder. Born on October 22, 1935 at Carroll, Iowa, Roger Bernard was the son of

Walter and Christine (Grote) Snyder. He grew up in the Breda community and graduated from St. Bernard's High School in 1953. On August 30, 1958 Roger was united in marriage to Bette Siepker at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Carroll. To this union were 7 children. Rucker farmed his entire life in the Breda area. He was very dedicated to the Breda community being active in the church and a member of the St. Bernard School Board where he was active in helping with the transition into the Kuemper Catholic School System.

Rucker enjoyed helping his neighbors. He was only a phone call away when a farmer needed a ride, needed help fixing a flat tire, or just an ear to listen to other's life stories. He always seemed to have just the right tool to help his friends with their problems. He will be remembered by many for his countless acts of kindness. Rucker was a very dedicated Chicago Cubs fan. He was a member of St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda.
